Declaration of Pecuniary Interest Form

Pursuant to subsection 5.1, of the *Municipal Conflict of Interest Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Council members must file a written statement of interest with the Town Clerk when making a declaration of pecuniary interest, direct or indirect, at any Meeting.

I, Councillor Michael Thompson, declare a pecuniary interest in Items 1 and 2 on the January 21, 2019, Special Meeting of Council agenda.

I am making this declaration because (general nature of pecuniary interest):

After much consideration, I believe I need to declare a conflict due to my employment in the retail pharmacy industry. I have struggled with this decision as the issue is an important one for our community but, I believe it can be argued that I have a direct and/or indirect pecuniary interest in the matter. Therefore, to preserve the integrity of Council's decision-making process I have decided to err on the side of caution and declare a conflict. I do so, having complete confidence in my colleagues and their ability to deal with this matter.

I confirm that I will not vote on the matter, I will not take part in discussion on any question in respect of the matter, and I will not attempt in any way whether before, during or after the meeting to influence the voting on any such question.
