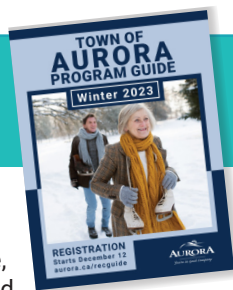

### Winterfest Camp - Junior and Senior

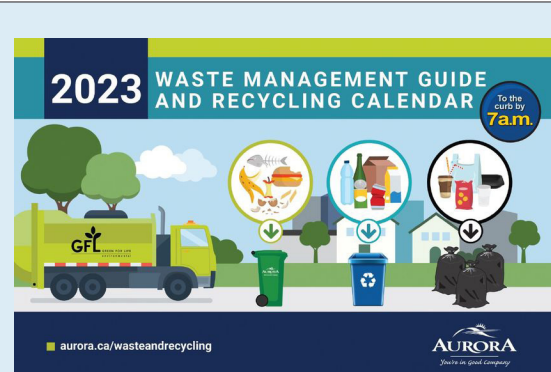
