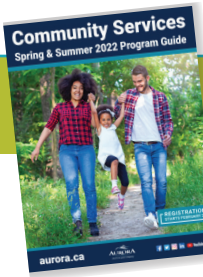

The Spongy moth eggs have begun to hatch and the caterpillars will start to feed on oak trees and on the leaves of other hardwood trees. To protect your trees, wrap them with burlap, pick off the caterpillars and dispose of them in a bucket of soapy water.

Community Services implements new pass validation system starting June 1

The Town of Aurora is launching a new Pass Validation System as of **June 1, 2022**. The implementation of this system will better assist customer service staff in managing recreation memberships, admission for drop-in activities and daily check-in of our facility users.

All facility users will be asked to obtain a "key tag" that will be linked to their e-PLAY account with their membership and/or ticket information, personal information and photo. This new module will offer a more seamless and streamlined purchasing and check-in process for our facility users at both the AFLC and SARC. With all memberships and pre-paid tickets on their account, clients no longer need to worry about losing their tickets or forgetting their recreation membership card.
