### Safe Water Disposal Practices

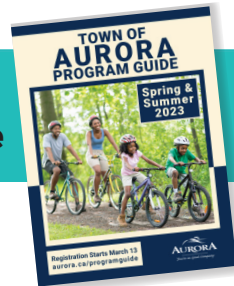
Pool season is just around the corner!
