The Parks and Recreation Infrastructure and Equipment Repair and Replacement Reserve Fund (the "Fund") is hereby established to receive and hold property tax sourced contributions for the purposes of funding major repairs, restorations, upgrades or replacement of the Town's parks, trails, open space or recreation assets, infrastructure and major equipment. Such owned assets include gazebo and band shell structures, sports fields and related fixed or portable equipment, field and pathway lighting, and any other related assets not classed as "minor equipment" or "small tools" by the Town's financial and budget policies.

Balances in the Fund will be planned for specific projects to be recommended to or by Council during the annual capital budget process, or other times throughout the year.

The target balance for this reserve fund is two (2) times the average annual spend as outlined in the annually updated Ten (10) Year Capital Plan of the Town.

At any time, acting in the best interests of the Town, Council may direct that some or all balances in the Fund be transferred to other reserve funds, or used for other purposes, provided that the transfer or use of tax sourced funding is appropriate in the circumstances.

The Fund is established to have a January 1, 2013 opening balance of \$644,001.13.
