

THIS PROJECT CONSISTS OF A PROPOSED EXPANSION TO AN EXISTING FUNERAL HOME FACILITY. THE EXPANSION WILL BE LIMITED TO THE WEST FACADE WITH A GROUND FLOOR AREA OF 149 m². THE ADDITIONAL GROUND FLOOR AREA WILL BE INTEGRATED WITH EXISTING USAGE SUCH AS VISITATION AND RECEPTION ROOMS. 




