Aurora's stormwater ponds are not designed or intended for recreational use such as skating or sliding. These ponds are part of the Town's drainage system and have flowing water under the surface. Water levels can change quickly causing the ice surface to weaken. Skating on ponds is not permitted and is extremely dangerous. Please use caution around frozen ponds.
