On **Saturday, October 29**, residents can place their unwanted, gently used items to the curb marked "Free" for others to take.

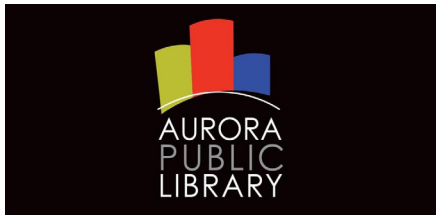
This initiative helps divert unwanted items out of the landfill. All uncollected items should be removed from the curb after 5 p.m.
