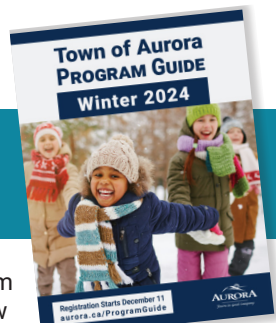


Municipal holiday hours
