Featured Artist: Ronald Clucas - Automotive Art Werks

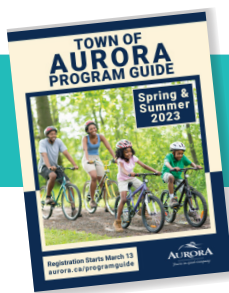
