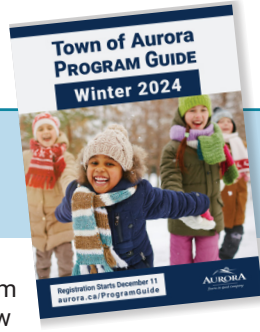

Water levels can change quickly causing the ice surface to weaken. Skating on ponds is not permitted and is extremely dangerous. Please use caution around frozen ponds.
