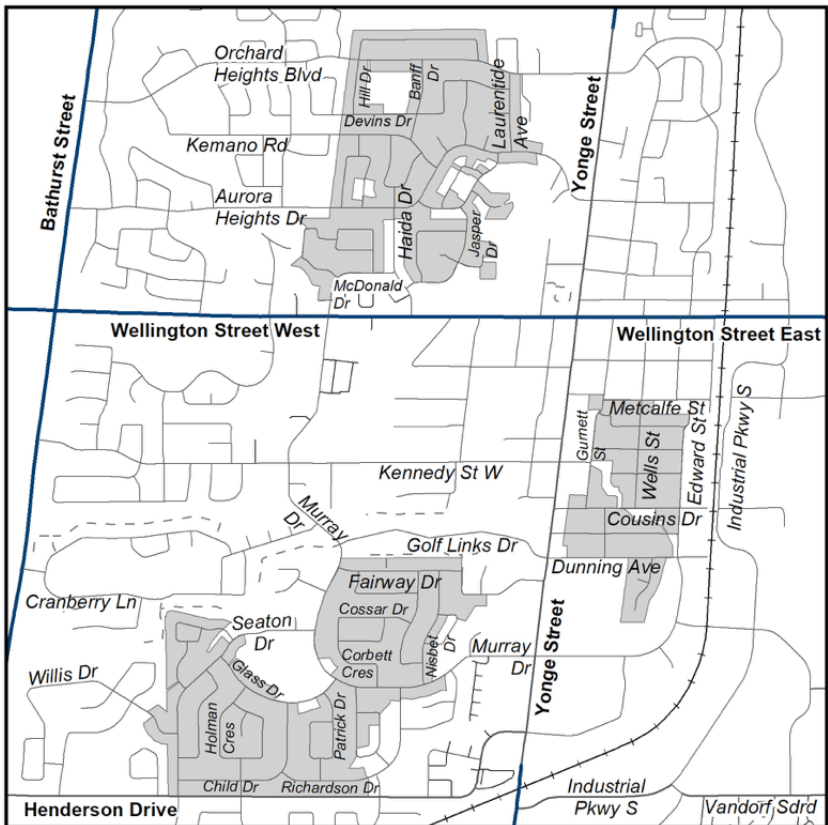
This is a great opportunity for residents to express what improvements or changes they would like see to the Town's Zoning Bylaw in order to protect the character of our existing neighbourhoods.
