- ◆ Partners can adopt a park, open space or trail system
- ◆ The Town will assist our partners by providing materials, equipment, and on site supervision for clean-up or planting.
- ◆ The Town currently has over 50 parks and open space lands in addition to over 25 kilometres of trails that are eligible for adoption.

Trees and Shrubs:

Purchased and planted by community groups and volunteers in designated areas of the Town

Gardens:

Weeding and watering of shrub and flower beds and planting of bulbs, annuals & perennials

Park Inspections:

Reporting worn out or damaged furniture, playground equipment, lights or fencing; dangerous trees or unsafe conditions

Maintenance & Repairs:

Painting of parks furniture/equipment, minor restoration work such as levelling, filling, top dressing

Beautification:

Picking up debris & litter from walkways, parking lots, sports fields, playgrounds, gardens and fence lines
