Outdoor Rinks Update




Town staff are working on installing outdoor rinks in Town Park, Machell Park and Ada Johnson Park. Staff will be filling the rinks with water so the rinks can freeze over the next couple of days. These are natural outdoor rinks with no refrigeration and are solely dependent on outdoor weather conditions. The Town will notify the public once the outdoor rinks are ready for use.


