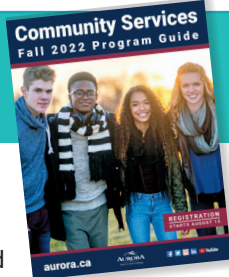

This initiative helps divert unwanted items out of the landfill. All uncollected items should be removed from the curb after 5 p.m.

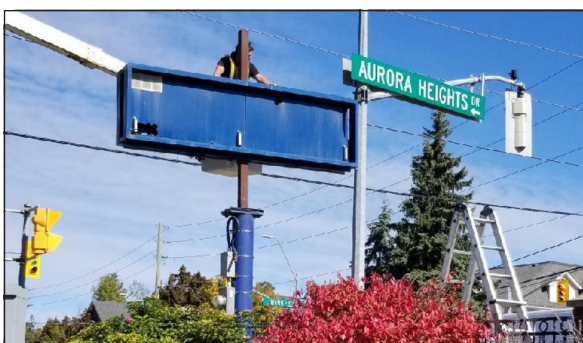
