



# PROCLAMATION

## NATIONAL DAY OF MOURNING April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2021

**WHEREAS** the National Day of Mourning has been recognized since April 28<sup>th</sup>, 1991;  
and

**WHEREAS** on April 28<sup>th</sup> we honour the millions of Ontarians impacted by a workplace fatality, injury or illness; and

**WHEREAS** according to the Canadian Centre for Occupational Health and Safety in the twenty year period from 1995 – 2014, 18,039 people lost their lives due to work related causes (an average of 902 deaths per year); and

**WHEREAS** the National Day of Mourning has since spread to about 80 countries around the world.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, on behalf of the Corporation of the Town of Aurora, I, Mayor Tom Mrakas, do hereby proclaim the day of **April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2021** as the **National Day of Mourning** in the Town of Aurora.
