



Proclamation

National Day of Remembrance and Action on Violence Against Women

Tuesday, December 6, 2022

Whereas on December 6, 1989 a massacre occurred at a Canadian University that shook our nation. A young man walked in l'Ecole Polytechnique in Montreal and killed 14 women and injured another 10; and

Whereas on average, every six days a woman in Canada is killed by her partner, and this year thousands of women will face violence in the form of harassment, assault, intimate partner violence and many other forms of abuse; and

Whereas ending violence against women can be achieved through continued antiviolence education programs and with constant reminders of our responsibility to treat all members of society with dignity and respect; and

Whereas we can work towards eliminating violence against women through our individual actions in naming the violence when we witness it and supporting those who are affected whether it be at home, school, the workplace or in public spaces.

Therefore be it resolved that, on behalf of the Corporation of the Town of Aurora, I, Mayor Tom Mrakas, do hereby proclaim the day of **Tuesday, December 6, 2022 as National Day of Remembrance and Action on Violence Against Women** in the Town of Aurora.
