- BY-LAW REQUIREMENT:** 1) Section 10.1 of the Zoning By-law allows fitness centres provided that no part of building in which such uses are located are used for any commercial self-storage facility, warehouse, industrial use, motor vehicle body shop or motor vehicle repair garage.
- PROPOSAL:** 1) The Applicant is proposing a fitness centre in part of building that contains industrial and warehouse uses; thus requiring a Variance from this provision of the By-law.

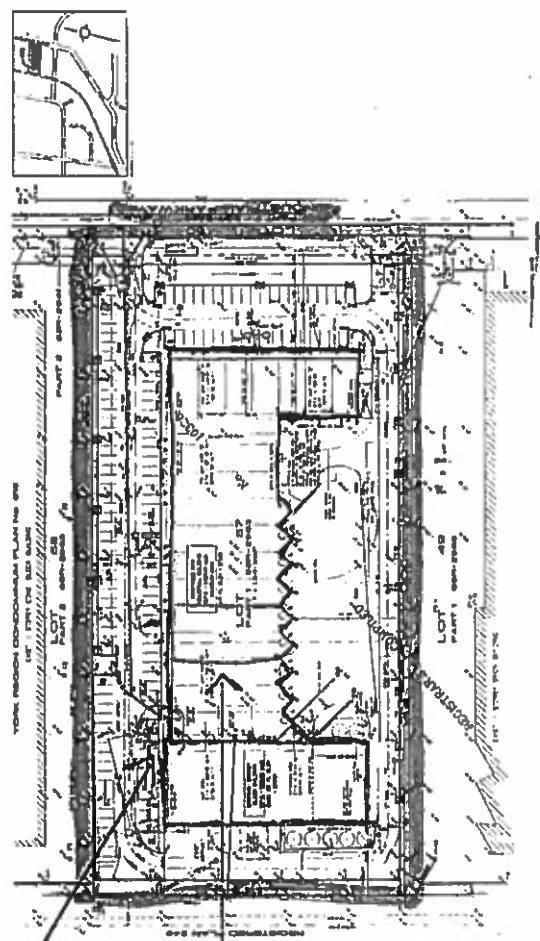
