Should this date fall on a holiday or weekend, you will have until 4:30pm of the next business day to file your appeal. Please note an additional fee (which can be found in the Fee By-law on our website, www.aurora.ca), per Application, payable to the Town of Aurora is required with respect to Ontario Municipal Board appeal submissions.

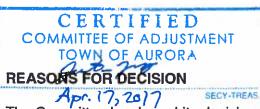

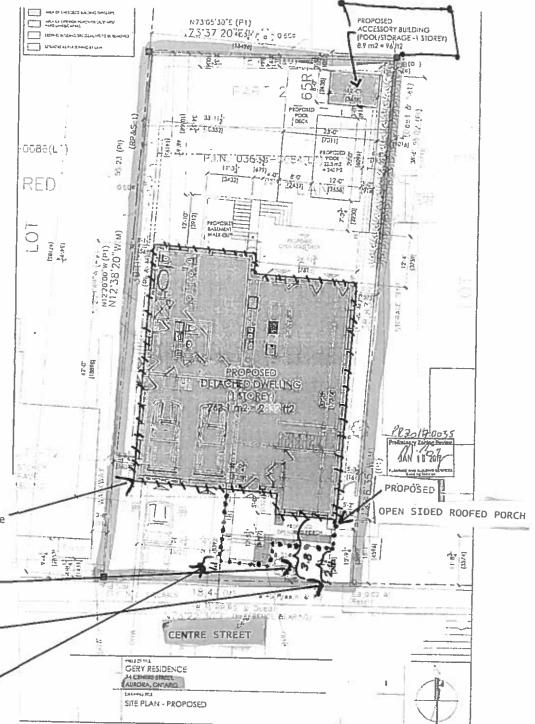

PROPOSED VARIANCES:

MV-2017-02D: To construct a **263.1** m2 detached dwelling with lot coverage of 38%; thus requiring Variance of 3%.

MV-2017-02A: To construct a 263.1 m2 detached dwelling which is 3.8 metres to front property line; thus requiring Variance of 2.2 metres.

MV-2017-02B: To construct open sided roofed porch which is 2.4 metres from front property line; thus requiring Variance of 2.1

MV-2017-02C: To construct porch steps which are 1.1 metres from front property line; thus requiring variance of 3.4 metres.
