- Must wear full equipment (including mouth guard, neck guard and helmet with cage).
- No contact.
- No age exceptions will be made.
- Family Stick & Puck Hockey and Parent & Child Stick & Puck/Skate maximum of 3 children per parent **on ice**.

NOTE: The Ontario Recreation Facilities Association and the Town of Aurora recommend wearing a helmet and glove protection while on the ice surface.
