Reporting to the Supervisor, Roads/Traffic, this position is responsible to perform routine inspections and patrolling of the municipalities roadways and sidewalks to observe both weather and road conditions in the field and electronically to determine if a winter event response is required in accordance with Provincial Maintenance standards. Additionally, you will perform maintenance of municipal roads including preparing roads for resurfacing, performing hot and cold asphalt patching, litter and debris pick-up, street sweeping, snow clearing/hauling /removal and winter salting operations. This includes the operation of a snowplough with wing, sidewalk snowplough/sanders, dump trucks, front end loader or other hand and power equipment.

To be considered for this opportunity, you are experienced in winter roads patrol, road maintenance/construction and/or repair work related to roads, road allowances, sewers, signs, catch basins, ditches, sidewalks and curbs, asphalt repairs. You are able to safely operate 6 ton dump trucks, loaders, sidewalk tractors and other hand and power equipment. Experienced in Municipal road snow ploughing and salting with combination dump truck front plough and side wing.

You are able to deal courteously and effectively with staff and the general public. You demonstrate good organizational, record-keeping, analytical and problem-solving skills. You have a strong comprehension of applicable Health and Safety regulations and principles, and practical knowledge of the safe operation of related equipment. Working knowledge of various road patrol software programs, mobile applications and outlook is considered a strong asset for this position

Standby/on call is a mandatory requirement of this position and must be available to work: days, evenings, nights and weekends including 24-hour on-call. You must be available to work overnight shifts from 11:00pm – 7:00am, Wednesday to Sunday. This position also requires a high school diploma or equivalent. A Class DZ licence in good standing would be an asset. Working knowledge related software applications and record keeping is considered a strong asset for this position.

Successful applicants to this position will be required to provide a Police Criminal Record Check, Driver's Abstract, and CVOR Abstract that is satisfactory to the Town prior to their start date.
