Ms. Jones presented an overview of the Canadian Hearing Society (CHS) and noted that this non-profit, charitable organization's mission is to provide full access and remove communication barriers for people with hearing disabilities. She advised on programs and services offered by CHS and noted various areas of the *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005*. Ms. Jones advised on communication barriers, the importance of understanding accommodation needs, and various ways and devices, including auditory and visual aids, that are available to facilitate communication and barrier-free access. She provided a demonstration of Ubi-Duo, and presented a short movie on providing and promoting customer service at recreational centres by better understanding the challenges and barriers that need to change.
