We would like to be available to clarify information submitted by the Town staff and the Chamber board and staff as well as respond to questions.

By letter dated June 17, 2014 (**Attachment 1**), Councillor Ballard has provided written notice of his resignation from the office of Councillor in accordance with subsection 260(1) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, and has requested that Council suspend his remuneration for the period of June 13, 2014 through to the date of his resignation from the office of Councillor.
