Dear Mayor Dawe & Members of Council:

On Tuesday, April 10, 2018, the Ladies in Philanthropy for Southlake (LiPS) group will host a Celebration of Spring Fashion Show in the showroom of the Highland Chevrolet Buick GMC Cadillac dealership in Aurora (15783 Yonge St). This is an annual event that raises funds for Southlake Regional Health Centre and is open to the public with a limited number of tickets available. Included with admission is a single beverage voucher, as well as a charitable donation to Southlake. On behalf of LiPS, we request that His Worship, the Mayor of Aurora and Members of Council recognize and declare this event to be significant to the municipality, fulfilling the requirement of the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario needed to approve the application for a Special Occasion Permit – which is due prior to April 10, 2018.

Every year, more than 110,000 people rely on Southlake for care. Community support funds 100% of the most urgently-needed tools, equipment and technology across the hospital, so that Southlake's staff have the tools they need to perform innovative procedures and save lives. From replacing ageing equipment to putting the newest, state-of-the-art tools in the hands of our staff, support from events like Highland's LiPS Celebration of Spring Fashion Show means that patients in our growing community can continue to rely on our hospital to provide world-class care close to home.
