#### **Executive Summary**

The purpose of this report is to inform Council of an upcoming Recreation Facility Sponsorship pilot project, involving enhancements to the arena dressing rooms. Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services is entering into a short-term facility advertising agreement with SticksIn Ltd., beginning in August, 2017.

Pending successful results with the pilot project, the full program would subsequently be rolled out to all Town arenas, and expanded to include arena dressing room hallways, and arena player benches.

#### Background

# SticksIn Ltd. pilot project program offers the following enhancements for arena dressing rooms

As part of the Recreation Facility Sponsorship Program, we are entering into a pilot project with SticksIn Ltd., for arena dressing room enhancements which consists of the following:

- Arena Dressing Rooms (interior)
- Branded stick holders
- Branded Coaches white board
- Motivational Signage on walls

- RESPECT
- TEAMWORK
- INSPIRE
- Sport Concierge (branded signage directing people to sport-related info website)
- Branded "Hero Seat", to be used to acknowledge "player of the game" or other team recognition
- Branded garbage can holder
- Blue Tooth Speaker (to be confirmed)

Arena Dressing Rooms (exterior)

- Branded sign holder at dressing room entrance
- Branded "Future Star" photo background in hallway, themed for both hockey and skating

**Player Benches** 

- Branded Stick Holder
- Branded coaches clip board holder

Note: Branded items include the logo recognition for SticksIn Ltd. sponsor organizations, which fund the overall program.

#### Analysis

# If this pilot is successful sponsorship money will be received by the Town on a per dressing room basis

The Town receives sponsorship revenue on a per dressing room basis, and at the same time provides and enhanced atmosphere within the arena dressing rooms.

The pilot is schedule for one dressing at the Aurora Community Centre (ACC) and one dressing room at the Stronach Aurora Recreation Complex (SARC), beginning in August for up to 120 days. During this time SticksIn Ltd. will be conducting market research via on-site surveys. The pilot program shall only consist of the interior dressing room components.

Following completion of the pilot, we may then move forward with implementation in all arena dressing rooms at all three recreation facilities, including all components of the program as listed above.

#### **Financial Implications**

There are no financial implications for the initial pilot project. If the full program is implemented, the Town will receive \$100 per year for each dressing room included in the program.




