Executive Summary

The purpose of this report is to provide the semi-annual report of the allocation of funds for the Culture and Recreation Grant. The total allocation for 2018 is \$9,011.34.

Background

Each year Council allocates funds from the Operating Budget in support of the Culture and Recreation Grant. This Grant was combined with the former Arts & Culture Grant in 2010.

The Community Services Department currently administers this grant and updates on the allocation of funds are presented to Council on a bi-annual basis.

Analysis

Allocation of funds

The Culture and Recreation Grant has been allocated a total of \$16,000 for 2018. Since the last report presented to Council (CMS18-012) in May 2018, 6 applications were received and approved totalling \$5,011.34, and two *John West Memorial Scholarships* were awarded totalling \$2,000. The following table shows the breakdown of funds between the organizations who received funding:
