Subject: Use of Veto Powers – Amendments to 2024-2026 Mayor's

Budget and shorten the veto period

In accordance with Part VI.1 (Special Powers and Duties of Head of Council) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, Subsections 284.16(4) power to veto a resolution passed under Subsection 284.16(3);

The Mayor hereby directs the following;

- 1. That the Mayor's veto power under Subsection 284.16(4) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001 be used to veto the following amendments that were adopted by Council at its Special Meeting on November 27, 2023;
 - Amendment 003 That the 2024 Aurora Sports Hall of Fame grant be reduced to \$43,795.75 total.
 - Amendment 005 That 1 customer service position and 2 facility
 positions are phased in no sooner than April 1, 2024, or adjusted later to
 meet any further delay of the opening; and That the remaining 2 facility
 positions be hired on an as-needed basis, thereafter, using a phased-in
 approach.
- 2. That, in the opinion of the Mayor, the amendments be vetoed as they undermine the Town's ability to succeed and to build the town in a positive manner; and,
- 3. That this Mayoral Decision provides written notice under Subsection 284.16(4) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, and Subsection 7(7) of O. Reg. 530/22 to shorten the 10-day period to veto an amendment resolution passed by Town Council to the proposed budget, to the date of this Mayoral Decision.
