Brain Injury Awareness Month

June, 2023

Whereas approximately 1.5 million people in Canada are living with a brain injury and statistics indicate that 100,000 Canadians will experience a brain injury each year; and

Whereas in Ontario there are almost half a million people living with a brain injury and 18,000 new cases are added every year; and

Whereas brain injury is the leading cause of death and disability for Canadians under the age of 40; and

Whereas the mission of the Brain Injury Association of York Region is to bring awareness of the prevalence of brain injuries in our community, support those affected by a brain injury and educate about the prevention of brain injuries

Therefore be it resolved that, on behalf of the Corporation of the Town of Aurora, I, Mayor Tom Mrakas, do hereby proclaim the month of June, 2023 as Brain Injury Awareness Month in the Town of Aurora.
