### OSPCA Wildlife Response Protocol

The Town of Aurora's Animal Control contractor is the Ontario SPCA. An OSPCA officer is scheduled to work in Aurora for 40 hours a week, on various shifts during the weekend and weekdays.

#### **During scheduled hours:**

During scheduled hours, if the town or the OSPCA is notified about injured or sick wildlife in Aurora it will send out an OSPCA officer to respond accordingly.

#### **Outside officer's scheduled hours**

Outside of scheduled shift hours, if the town or the OSPCA is notified about injured or sick wildlife the OSPCA will not be dispatched **except** in instances where an animal endangers the health and safety of people or other animals.

**Emergency call - danger to the public:** If any animal becomes a threat or danger to the community, the OSPCA officer will be dispatched regardless of the day or time.
