This theatre production is a WWII thriller in the spirit of Casablanca and The Imitation Game. At a ceremony honouring female WWII spies, Cleo discovers her sweet, sock-knitting grandmother Audette was actually a covert agent in Nazi-occupied France. A hidden Jew and unlikely recruit to the British SOE, Audette used her age, gender, and knitting needles to outsmart the Nazis and pass coded intel to the Allies. As Cleo unravels her grandmother's secret past, she's forced to confront her own identity—and decide whether to hide it or embrace it in a world where history risks being erased.
