Authorization for Agent to File Nomination

Section 33(1) of the *Municipal Elections Act, 1996* provides that a person may be nominated for an office by filing a nomination in the Clerk's office, in person or by an agent. If a candidate wishes to use an agent to file their nomination, the following must be completed and signed prior to filing of the nomination.

to file the Nomination Paper and any required documentation on my behalf and, as my agent for this nomination, execute all necessary documentation and provide any of my personal information that will be required during the nomination process.

If an agent is filing the nomination paper on your behalf, the candidate's declaration of qualification must be commissioned by any commissioner of oaths, prior to the agent filing the paper. The agent must provide proof of eligibility for the candidate and proof identity for themselves, but they do not need to be eligible to run for office.
